I heard a story that was written in the Des Moines Register about a famous Iowan named Alvin Straight. Straight, a 73-year-old who had limited vision and no driver's license, wanted desperately to see his brother in Wisconsin 240 miles away. Strait's brother had suffered a serious stroke and was unable to communicate by phone or other means.

For whatever reason, Straight didn't trust public transportation so decided to make the trip via his John Deer riding lawnmower. Determined as he was, he loaded a ten-foot trailer full of gas and camping equipment and set off on his journey. His trip took six weeks enduring harsh weather and a breakdown along the way but never giving up until his mission of love was complete.

Straight's commitment and devotion finally paid off; he cared for and prayed daily for his brother until almost total recovery happened months later. As a result, his story caught national attention and besides celebrity appearances, Straight's story was eventually made into a movie and is still available today.

I wonder how the world would be changed if other Christians everywhere demonstrated the same kind of persistence, commitment, and devotion that he did? To serve the world without waiver like Christ did and does today. Have you ever dreamed of how you would like to serve the Lord but decided before you ever got started that the hurdles before you would be too high to overcome? I sure have!

I know that more lives could be changed for Christ if people worried less about the practicality of their dreams and instead decided to take them on courageously. So how about today we ask God to give us that courage and convict our hearts to follow through. Be our inspiration and encouragement to take on whatever life sends our way.
