

Holy Week Services, March 20 & 24

Our Holy Week observance begins on March 20 with Palm Sunday in the Park, a joyful service celebrating Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. We will gather in front of the church at 9:45 AM to receive palms and walk to the Wilson Park together, joining other churches coming from all directions around the park for the 10 o'clock service.



We will observe **Maundy Thursday** and **Good Friday** on **Thursday**, **March 24**, **at 6:00 PM**.

Beginning in the Fellowship Hall, there will be a Passover Seder reenactment of the Last Supper with communion. The Good Friday service of darkness, known as Tenebrae, will take place in the Sanctuary.
