"Palm Sunday in the Park," March 20, has been moved to Holy Trinity Lutheran Church (on Church Street Ext. across from Wilson Park) due to the forecast of cold rainy weather. Still, it will be a joyful service as we join other churches to celebrate Jesus'



Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. Palms will be available at our church for those who want to park there and walk up to the Lutheran Church (say, if you're coming from the early service).



We will observe **Maundy Thursday** and **Good Friday** on **Thursday**, **March 24**, **at 6:00 PM**.

Beginning in the Fellowship Hall, there will be a Passover Seder reenactment of the Last Supper with communion. The Good Friday service of darkness, known as Tenebrae, will take place in the Sanctuary.
