# **PDA Responds to Louisiana Flooding**

In the aftermath of catastrophic flooding in the Gulf region, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance is providing assistance to the Presbytery of South Louisiana and reached out to the Presbytery of Mississippi. PDA has approved two grants to be used to address community needs.



The flooding this August dumped nearly 22 inches of rain in parts of Louisiana and other Gulf states according to the National Weather Service.

Some communities reported as much as 31 inches of rainfall.

"Presbyterian Disaster Assistance joins the whole church in expressing its sadness and extending prayerful support to our neighbors in southern Louisiana and Mississippi in the wake of the flooding," said the Rev. Dr. Laurie Kraus, coordinator for PDA. "We are grateful for the church's faithful past giving and support of **One Great Hour of Sharing**, which has enabled PDA to make financial resources immediately available to affected communities." ...
