Dear First Presbyterian Family,

I pray that everyone had a blessed and safe Thanksgiving! In my sermon this

past Sunday, I spoke about beginning the process of discovering what is essential for our life as God's people, and allowing God's light to illuminate our path forward. I quoted former Secretary General of the UN, Dag Hammarskjold, who said, "For all that we have been, thanks! To all that will be, yes!" We are called to thank God and each other for all that we are and have been together as we follow God's YES for our future.

In our process of praying and dreaming with God, it is now time to plan the next steps in our adaptive change.
