Dear First Presbyterian family,

This week I have been drawn to the fable of the hummingbird. I grew up on Aesop's fables and in my adult life I've frequently re-read Friedman's Fables by Edwin H. Friedman. Stories seep into us in transformative ways ~ often before we realize we are being changed. Jesus teaches us through story and the Hebrew bible is filled with stories that form us as God's people.

The parable/fable of the hummingbird has been circulating recently because of it's obvious connection to the destructive fires on the west coast of our country. But the stories' power extends to any overwhelming thing or event we face. Every small response has a positive ripple effect. Any positive action becomes part of the work of the greater good.

If you haven't seen or heard it, here is the story:

According to an old Native American legend....

Once there was a great forest fire.

All the animals fled to the edge of the forest and froze in fear not knowing what to do. They watched as the flames began destroying the beauty of their home.

Finally a tiny hummingbird flew to a body of water and took a few drops into its beak. It then flew quickly toward the fire allowing the drops to fall on the roaring flames.

Over and over the tiny bird continued.

Drop by drop.

Back and forth.

Again and again.

The other animals watched from the edge of the forest, and called to the little bird, "What are you doing?"

The hummingbird replied, "I am doing the best I can."
