Devotional Meditation Elder, Monica Stevens July 20, 2022

Live in Christ Jesus Colossians 2:6-10

"So live in Christ Jesus the Lord in the same way as you received him. Be rooted and built up in him, be established in faith, and overflow with thanksgiving just as you were taught. See to it that nobody enslaves you with philosophy and foolish deception, which conform to human traditions and the way the world thinks and acts rather than Christ. All the fullness of deity lives in Christ's body. And you have been filled by him, who is the head of every ruler and authority." (CEB)

Many of the difficulties Paul and the early church faced seem very contemporary. The church at Colossae was being tempted to alter the gospel that was preached to them by Paul's co-worker, Epaphras. Some groups were preaching that the only real way to be a Christian was to follow the Jewish laws regarding dietary restrictions, holy days, the Sabbath, and circumcision. Others proclaimed that they had a "higher knowledge" involving secretive mystical experiences that enhanced their spirituality and made them superior to other Christians. We may not have to contend with the false teachings of the Jewish-Christian sects or the Gnostics, but there are plenty of people and groups that will tell you that they are the only "true" Christians and unless you believe what they believe and live your faith in the same way they do, you have missed the mark and your faith is in vain.

John 3:16-17 provides us with the simple truth that, "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him won't perish but will have eternal life. God didn't send his Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through him." (CEB) In John 15, Jesus tells us, "As the Father loved me, I too have loved you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have said these things to you so that my joy will be in you and your joy will be complete. This is my commandment: love each other as I have loved you." (vs. 9-12, CEB) The very heart of our Christian faith is to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and to live in his love by loving others.

As Paul told the Colossians in our opening scripture, "So live in Christ Jesus the Lord the same way you received him. Be rooted and built up in him, be established in faith, and overflow with thanksgiving as you were taught." The more we live our lives in Christ, the deeper, richer, and fuller our faith becomes. We work to nurture our faith and deepen our relationship with Christ through prayer, study, thanksgiving, service, and life within the community of believers.

Just as it was during Paul's lifetime, there are plenty of people and groups who want to "improve" or "embellish" Jesus' gospel. Their ideas can cause doubt and confusion among believers and cause people to engage in a destructive sort of completion that demeans the faith of others in their quest to be the "best," "purest," or "most righteous" Christian. We need to stay rooted in the in the love of Jesus and build up our own faith and the faith of others by living in and sharing that love. Our mission is a simple and as difficult as that.

Gracious heavenly Father, we thank you that you have sent your Son, Jesus, into the world to reveal the depth of your love for us and all of creation. Help us to keep Jesus at the center of our lives so that we may grow in our faith, resist things that would separate us from your love, and become vessels to spread the joy of your love wherever we go and in whatever we do. We pray this is the love of God, the grace of Jesus Christ, and the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
