Can you hear my long sigh? And by Day 4, divorce was named as one of the big griefs. (another long sigh....)

During our Adaptive Change workshop, we heard that we do not fear change, we fear loss. And on Day 3 we were reminded that "if change is happening, grief is happening." I can hold to the promise of hope and new life, because I've seen it in so many \sim even in you. We are both individually and collectively becoming something new. God is doing a new thing. And we find blessings in all that God and our faith community has seen us through. Thanks be to God!
