Dear First Presbyterian family,

Over the next few weeks, I will be on the phone making calls to all of you. My primary goals are to begin getting to know you and to hear how you have been engaging church during the pandemic. I know that some have simply gotten out of the habit of worship, and many have created new habits of worshiping online. As we look to our future and begin naming who we are and who God is calling us to be, we need to find ways to include all the voices of our membership.

Some of us are enjoying online worship. It has been interesting to watch the national trends. People are worshiping with coffee in hand in their homes and at times other than Sunday morning. Our service, at First Presbyterian Martinsville is viewed on average, 77 times during each week. In all that we do moving forward, we will need to find ways to connect our online community with our in-person community.
