


A Feast of Carols Sunday, January 8

It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. I Corinthians 13:4-7

This wonderful piece of Scripture from the Apostle Paul's letter to the church in Corinth describes God's greatest expression of love to the world in Jesus Christ.
