Pastor's Corner

Walking in God's Light

This is the message we have heard from Him and declare to you: God is light; in Him there is no darkness at all. If we claim to have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all sin. I John 1:5-7

Easter morning, that first burst of light that we celebrate as the victory of the Resurrection, reminds us that a life in Christ does not end in darkness! Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life."

When you walk with Jesus, you walk in the light that allows us to see where we're going. Without the light of God, your life is merely a guess. Walking in the light results in two important relationships. First, the

fellowship with one another, or a right relationship with our family and friends. Second, when we walk with Jesus, His light purifies us from sin and restores a right relationship with God!

So, this Easter let us be reminded, regardless of the weather, it's not just another Sunday. It's Son Day! May the light of God envelope your living now and forever more!


Congregational Meeting
