Our church location is a collaboration of seven Martinsville churches that also includes Broad Street Christian, Calvary Christian, Christ Episcopal, First Baptist, Forest Hills Presbyterian, and Starling Avenue Baptist. Our cluster has a goal of 300 students to be served; the total event goal for the county and surrounding area is 4,000 students.

This year we will supply new socks, shoes, backpacks with supplies, and a free age-appropriate book from Smart Beginnings. Breakfast and/or lunch will be provided by the Henry County School system summer feeding program at both registrations and event day.

**Sponsoring a child is \$20**, and our goal is 300 kids. We will have a “shoe tree” for congregants to sponsor a child.

**Volunteers will be needed** for all the events listed above. Pack the Bus will take place at Walmart. Packing the backpacks will take place at 700 Commerce Court, Martinsville.
